
SIBERIAN HUSKY PUPPY PURCHASE AGREEMENT

Running with Huskies

DATE:

The following agreement is between Running with Huskies 'Seller' and 'Purchaser'.

We require a non-refundable deposit of \$500 in order to hold a puppy and will be applied to the total purchase price. The balance must be paid in full at the time the puppy is picked up by the purchaser. If shipping is required the remaining balance must be paid by 6 weeks of age to allow time for shipping arrangements and confirmation. Shipping is an additional \$600 and covers airfare, shipping crate, and required health documents. If the remaining balance is not paid by the 8 week date then the seller assumes the right to re-list the puppy for sale.

HEALTH GUARANTEE

The seller believes, to the best of their knowledge, all puppies sold are in good health. Prior to leaving the seller's care, a licensed veterinarian performs all vaccinations and health checks. All vet records will be turned over to the purchaser when the puppy is picked up. Wormings are done at the ages of 2, 3, 4, 6 and 7-8 weeks. However due to the ease of which puppies may acquire parasites, especially during transit, there is no guarantee against worms, nor does the seller take responsibility for any illness or death caused by parasites. It is the owner's responsibility to continue with preventative treatments including veterinary checkups, recommended vaccinations, wormings, and spay/neuter procedures.

Please consider we are dealing with living creatures, and though every precaution may be taken to ensure healthy and viable puppies, occasionally nature throws an unforeseen curve ball and a puppy is born a little different. This may not be apparent until later in the dog's life as genetic anomalies do not always show immediately. There are no known congenital abnormalities in the breeding pair, however anomalies do occur in nature. Adopting any animal will carry this risk. If your puppy within the first three years is found by a licensed veterinarian to have a life threatening health issue that cannot be corrected by surgery, therapy, or controlled by medication, then we will offer a replacement puppy out of the next available litter. Written documentation of said illness must be provided from a licensed veterinarian directly to the seller's veterinarian within three business days of identifying the issue. The following causes are not included in the warranty since they can be transmitted very easily upon exposure: parasites of any type, viruses, Parvo, Distemper, Bacteria infections, (yeast, urine, hot spots), fleas, mites, dog lice.

If said puppy is euthanized or dies, buyer must do an autopsy at buyer's own expense to prove what puppy dies of.

The seller is not responsible for any costs accrued after sale of the puppy. We will not under any circumstances whatsoever pay for any vet bills, food, destruction of property, medication, x-rays, etc.

RESPONSIBILITY OF PUPPY OWNERSHIP

Adopting a Husky puppy is a decision not to be taken lightly. Huskies can live 12 to 15 years on average and they will be active and demanding during this time. By signing this agreement you acknowledge that you have prior experience with huskies and their ownership demands, and/ or have done the proper research to ensure adopting a husky puppy is the right decision for you and you are prepared to put in the effort it takes to raise a husky. You also agree to the proper training and care of the puppy to ensure its health and wellbeing for the dog's entire lifespan.

Puppies are sold with *Limited* AKC registration. This means NO BREEDING. Any puppies born or sired from this puppy will not be recognized by the AKC. Spaying/neutering should be done by the puppy's first birthday and is always recommended to prevent some illnesses associated with the dog's reproductive system, as well as deter some unwanted behaviors.

If at any time you find yourself unwilling or unable to care for your dog it is the owner's responsibility to find a new home. A well trained and well cared for husky is remarkably easy to re-home and the breeder can suggest places to advertise, or sometimes even recommend new potential adopters who are actively searching for an adult husky.
